Novello di Teroldego Igt Vigneti delle Dolomiti

The great interest shown by wine estates in producing this special kind of wine started in the years 1970-1980, further justified by the new trends in consumer tastes that demand young and ready to drink wines that are fresh, fruity and well-rounded.

The Mezzolombardo winery was the first in Trentino to successfully experiment this technique and today produces the "novello" (new wine) par excellence, the one that indisputably is of the best quality.

Vineyard location:

Piana Rotaliana comprendente i comuni di Mezzolombardo, Mezzocorona e San Michele all'Adige

Age of vines:

From 25 to 30 years

Cultivation:

Classic double Trentino pergola

Planting density:

3,000 vines/hectare

Soil:

Light, not very deep soil (70-80 cm), rather fertile and always well drained, supported by a rich multi-layered structure of pebbles, gravel and sand

Vinification and ageing:

Vinification by 100% carbonic maceration of whole Teroldego grapes alone
